### Burnable Waste

**How to Dispose:**  
Place in the **designated garbage bags** and write your name on the bag.

**Accepted Items:**

- Kitchen waste (drain well)
- Paper scraps
- Clothing and textiles
- Cooking oil (absorb in paper or solidify), etc.

**Important Notes:**  
Large burnable items (futon, carpets, wood scraps): Bring directly to Tarui Clean Center (fees apply). Wood: max. 50 cm long × 5 cm thick.



### Non-Burnable Waste

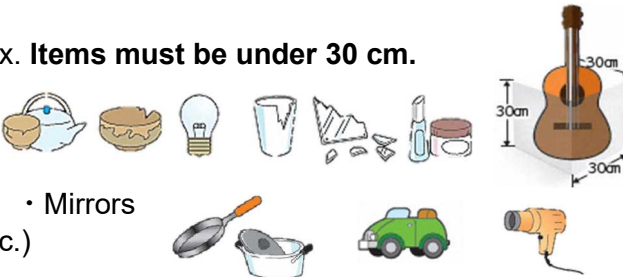
**How to Dispose:**  
Place in the designated box. **Items must be under 30 cm.**

**Accepted Items:**

- Ceramics / pottery
- Glassware / tableware
- Light bulbs / LED bulbs
- Mirrors
- Metalware (pots, pans, etc.)
- Hard plastics (toys, etc.)
- Small home appliances (excluding those with rechargeable batteries), etc.

**Notes:**

- Items over 30cm:** Classified as Bulky Waste (see town website)
- Umbrellas and Metal Baseball Bats:** Accepted even if over 30 cm.
- Spray Cans:** Empty completely and punch a hole before disposal.
- Rechargeable Batteries:** Small rechargeable batteries (e.g., lithium-ion) and products containing them cannot be collected through regular waste collection due to fire risk. Bring them to the Tarui Eco Dome.
- Large Quantities:** For large amounts of waste from moving or house cleaning, complete the required procedures at the Town Hall in advance and bring it directly to the processing facility (fees apply).



### Hazardous Waste

**How to Dispose:**  
Place in the designated boxes or cans by type.

**Accepted Items:**

- Gas lighters
- Fluorescent lamp
- Dry-cell batteries
- Button cell batteries

**Notes:**

- Glow starters (for fluorescent lights) and LED bulbs are NOT hazardous waste. Dispose as Non-Burnable Waste.

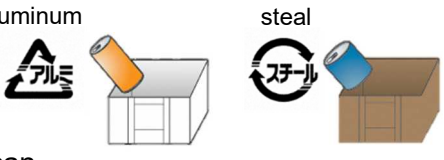

### Recyclable Waste

#### Aluminum Cans / Steel Cans

**How to Dispose:**  
Empty and rinse cans. Place in the designated boxes by type.

**Notes:**  
No aluminum mark → Dispose as steel can



#### Plastic Containers and Packaging

**How to Dispose:**  
Remove dirt and food residue. **Place in the designated garbage bags** and write your name on the bag.

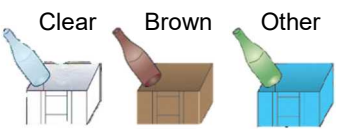
**Accepted Items:**  
Plastic containers and packaging with **Plastic Identification Mark** (recycling symbol).  
Examples: Food trays, bread and snack bags, egg cartons, plastic shopping bags, etc.



#### Glass Bottles

**How to Dispose:**  
Remove caps/lids and rinse thoroughly. Sort by color: Clear, Brown, Other. Place directly in designated boxes by color. Do not use bags.

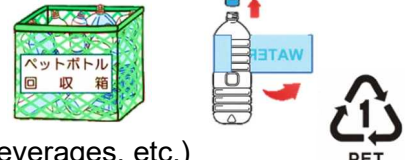
**Notes:**  
Cosmetic bottles → Dispose as Non-Burnable Waste.



#### PET Bottles

**How to Dispose:**  
Remove caps and labels, rinse bottles, and place in the green mesh basket.

**Accepted Items:**  
Only bottles with PET Identification Mark (beverages, etc.)



### Non-Collectible Items

**How to Dispose:**

- LP gas cylinders
- Fire extinguishers
- Car parts
- Batteries
- Pesticide containers
- Paint cans with remaining paint
- Air conditioners
- Televisions
- Refrigerators/Freezers
- Washing machines/Clothes dryers
- Business waste
- etc.

**How to Dispose:**

- Depending on the item, please follow the legally required recycling procedures, or consult the retailer where purchased or a specialized store.
- For business waste, please transport it to an appropriate disposal facility yourself, or hire a licensed waste collection and transportation contractor.

**Household Rubble (concrete, blocks, roof tiles, bricks):**  
Complete the required procedures at the Town Hall in advance and bring these items directly to the designated disposal site (fees apply).
